2016/4519/P	Alan Hamilton	Flat 4, 110-114 Grafton Road NW5 4BA	20/09/2016 11:00:48	COMMNT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There is nothing in the plans about what the impact will be or solutions for, the certain increase in sound bleed/noise pollution as a result of the new skylights, given their proximity to Flats 4 &amp; 6 and the fact they are in the roof allowing sound to escape vertically – given that the sound bleed from the studio upward is already significant.</li> <li>• The proposed changes to the fire escape allows greater access to both Flats 3 &amp; 4 from outside in a ward where the burglary statistics are 20% above the London average. It will also allow anyone of the fire escape to look directly into both flats, thereby damaging the privacy of the residents of both.</li> <li>• There is nothing in plans intended to tackle daily smoke drift from the outside area on the North of the building. This affects Flats: 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, with windows open and windows shut but window filters open. See: <a href="http://www.ash.org.uk/files/documents/ASH_827.pdf">http://www.ash.org.uk/files/documents/ASH_827.pdf</a></li> <li>• The outside area North is also an amplifier of sound because of its architectural qualities, the plans make no provision for alleviating this, and given the further enclosure of the space because of the extension it will lead to louder noise and more enclosed space for the smokers – channeling the latter smoke drift in a more concentrated stream towards the flats above.</li> </ul>
