The CGCA questions the need to relocate the three AC units to the first floor, where they will result in harm to adjacent residents' visual amenity and will cause noise and disturbance. The applicant states that these proposals are necessary due to the high temperatures at the current position at the basement lightwell. However, a more eco-friendly solution – and one that would be more appropriate given that this is a Grade II listed building – would be to install an air-heat extraction unit in the basement.</p> <p>Further, we note that the applicant's acoustic report indicates that more appropriate measures are acceptable (see p. 11 of acoustic assessment, Report Reference: 160608-002A, dated July 2016).</p> |
