Address: Former Royal Ear Hospital and Former Student Union Building Capper Street / Huntley Street London WC1E 6AP

Proposal: Details of proposed CHP required by condition 11 of permission reference 2015/1281/P dated 20/01/2016 (Erection of a 6 storey building and excavation works to create a 3 storey basement, comprising a head and neck outpatient hospital (Class D1) following demolition of the former UCL Student Union and Royal Ear Hospital buildings).

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant approval of details.

Informative(s):

1 Condition 11 of permission 2015/1281/P requires full details of the proposed CHP including manufacturers specification, demonstrating that NOx emissions associated with the CHP will be <95m2/Nm3.

The Council's Sustainability team has reviewed the details submitted and confirmed that the submitted details are acceptable and the requirements of the



condition have been met.

The site's planning history and relevant appeal decisions were taken into account when coming to this decision. The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed. The details submitted have been assessed in relation to the approved scheme, the site and its surroundings.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policies CS5 and CS16 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP26 and DP32 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
