1 Reasons for granting permission.

The submitted details are considered sufficient to demonstrate that the trees to be retained both on site and on neighbouring sites will be adequately protected during construction works. The report has been revised to now show the retention of a mature sycamore tree in an adjacent property of 37-39 Great Ormond Street,



which was originally due to be removed, in order to address concerns by the tree officer and a neighbour.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policy CS15 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy.
