On behalf of the Trustees of the Hampstead Wells and Campden Trust, (as owners of the land as defined by the notice)

I wish to make representations about the Notice of Application for Listed Building Consent under the Regulation 6 of the

Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Regulations 1990 regarding the proposed development at the Wharrie Cabmen's Shelter where Willmott Dixon are applying to LB Camden for permission to install monitoring equipment including tilt sensors and vibration sensors and cabling up on building elevations.

The Trustees have no objection in principle to this Application for Listed Building Consent, but would need assurance that

the section 106 agreement would incorporate provision for re-imbusement by the Royal Free Hospital if the subsequent work damaged the Shelter.
