Any newly diagnosed respiratory problems among the local residents would inevitably (rightly or wrongly) be blamed on the this enterprise and by association Camden Council.</p> <p>These two blocks house a substantial number of elderly residents and young children both groups who could be severely compromised by the potential dangers associated with exposure to these bioaerosols. It should also be noted that there are children's play areas and adult exercise equipment adjacent to these premises in Lismore Circus.</p> <p>We have been led to believe that the applicant has no commercial experience running this kind of enterprise and while we wish him every success in his endeavour we think it potentially dangerous, unfair and reckless to expose the whole estate to this new business' "learning curve", they are after all not growing lettuces and there are far more suitable locations available away from residential areas.</p> <p>Finally because of the nature of the building's construction noise reverberates around the whole structure this means that any heavy duty climate control equipment operating 24 hours a day will impact on the life quality of the residents.</p>
