Re: Mulberry Cottage, 5 Highgate West Hill, London N6 6AS

Please find below a quotation for proposed tree works at the above address.

<u>SPECIES</u>	<u>WORK PROPOSED</u>
<u>Rear</u> T1 Deodar Cedar x 1 (<i>Cedrus deodara</i>)	Large, mature tree. This tree has been poorly reduced in the past. The top was over reduced and this pushed the apical dominance in to the lateral branches. This has created a very dense upper crown with dog legged limbs. There are several lateral branches protruding from the crown line. To reduce mechanical loading and to maximise the light, the suggested works are: To reduce overlong lateral branches by up to 2m back into the main crown line, thin through the crown from branch tip to centre of the tree by 10%, remove deadwood.
<u>Rear right</u> T2 Silver Birch x 1 (<i>Betula pendula / alba</i>)	Mature tree. This tree is growing out over the lawn. To maximise the light, the suggested works are: To reduce the lateral spread over the lawn by 1 - 1.25m, thin through the crown by 5 - 10%, remove deadwood.
<u>Rear boundary</u> T3 Various x 1	Hollies, Tree privet and Holm oak. Large,

screening hedge. To maximise the light yet retain privacy screening, the suggested works are: To reduce the height by 1 - 1.5m, prune the lateral spread over Brookfield Mansions footpath back by up to 1m (do not leave holes), client to advise on the day.
