Please find below a quotation for proposed tree works at the above address.

<u>SPECIES</u>		<u>WORK PROPOSED</u>
<u>Rear left</u>		
T1 Sycamore x 1	(<i>Acer pseudoplatanus</i>)	Large, mature, previously reduced tree. To maintain the tree and to maximise the light, the suggested works are: To reduce back to the previous points of reduction, clean out crown, remove deadwood.
<u>Rear boundary</u>		
T2 Horse Chestnut x 1	(<i>Aesculus hippocastanum</i>)	Extra-large, mature, widespreading tree. This tree is suffering from Horse chestnut Leaf Miner. Repeated attacks have a cumulative effect. The tree doesn't get enough time to photosynthesise as the leaves are damaged by mid-summer. This means that the tree will be getting lower on energy every year as it can't replenish its stored energy. Pruning the tree will require energy from the tree to heal the wounds and propagate new growth. The tree should be pruned in mid winter to minimise the stress on the tree. The suggested works are: To reduce back to the previous points of reduction, clean out crown, remove deadwood.
