					1. Troyes House is part of a conservation area in which such an installation is totally inappropriate.
					2. Troyes House, being only 4 storeys high is a totally inappropriate site for phone masts. The signal will deliver high levels of radiation into the upper stories (where many children sleep) of all of the neighbouring houses.
					3. I am concerned about the effects that such high levels of electromagnetic radiation may have on the residents both of Troyes House (over 30% of whom class as 'vulnerable') and the surrounding area. Even though government regulations do not class phone mast emissions as dangerous, those regulations are based on 20 year old research. There is now much credible evidence in the public domain that the health of children and vulnerable people may be affected by high levels of radiation.
					4. In personal terms I am one of a group of people whose health is adversely affected by electromagnetic radiation. The installation of six masts 35 metres from my bedroom would have a dramatically negative effect of my health. The result may well be that I have to leave a house in which I have lived for 38 years and in which I have brought up my family.
					5. I am very unhappy at Camden's total failure to consult local residents about this proposal. Despite the fact that the project was initiated a year ago, we knew nothing of it until a month ago. Even then, only a small proportion of the residents who would be affected by the installation were informed and, despite several requests, we have still only been given the most basic information about the installation. I am also very concerned that the councillor tasked with looking after the resident's interests is also a member of the Finance, Technology and Growth Committee with whom this project originated - a clear conflict of interest.
