(AREA TPO REF. C40) REAR GARDEN: 1 x Ash - thin by 20% to remove new epicormic growth and deadwood. lift clear of Yew and Apple by 2m and trim back from house to clear 2m  
1 x Apple - thin by 20% and shape by shortening stagging branches.

The Council has considered your application dated 03 August 2016 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

Conditions and Reasons:

- 1 This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this decision or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.

- 2 All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 2010. (Recommendation for Tree Work)




Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the tree(s).
