Variation of Condition 2 (approved drawings) and removal of Condition 4 (details of facing brickwork) and Condition 7 (details of curtain wall framing and glazing) to planning permission ref 2016/1964 granted 26/07/2016

The Bloomsbury Association welcome the retention of the original windows but, that being the case, the colour needs to be as indicated on the approved drawings under application 2016/1964/P. Window frames should be coloured white, not black, and the spandrel panels between the windows a cream colour to match the existing facade, not grey. What has been revealed after the scaffolding was taken down is referential to the original proposal that was much criticised by the Bloomsbury Conservation Area Advisory Committee.
