The change of use from office (Class B1(a)) to 1x self-contained residential unit (Class C3) at ground floor level is permitted under Schedule 2, Part 3, Class O of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 2015

- In accordance with paragraph 0.2-(2) of this part, the development under Class O is permitted subject to the condition that it must be completed within a period of 3 years starting with the prior approval date.

- 3 You are advised that any external works of alterations or additions would require a further application for planning permission
- 4 You are reminded that this decision only grants permission for permanent residential accommodation (Class C3). Any alternative use of the residential units for temporary accommodation, i.e. for periods of less than 90 days for tourist or short term lets etc, would constitute a material change of use and would require a further grant of planning permission
