Dear Ms Walsh

I understand that an appeal has been lodged against the planning decision regarding the Mansfield Road Bowling Club site. I should like to join my many neighbours in reiterating our objections to the proposed housing development. In particular:

1. The site is designated for leisure use, and the offer to provide some 'open space' is too limited and not protected.
2. Similarly, it is by no means clear that the tennis club proposals are a binding commitment or one which could or would apply to any future developers, in the all too likely event that the site or parts of it are sold on.
3. While there is an acknowledged need for more housing in

Camden, as in all inner London boroughs, these proposals for high density, luxury dwellings do nothing to meet such a need and do not in any way contribute to the neighbourhood.
