I object to the proposed development. I live at the above address.

It would seem to me that the creation of new housing for the sole purpose of providing funding for a speculative developer is disproportionate to the loss of private open space and open air leisure activity space for the community.

The scheme also demands the removal of Tree 5 that affords screening and sound reduction from activity on the tennis courts. The boundary to this NE corner of the site seems to also vary from the existing site plan copy enclosed which is inaccurate and the proposed boundary treatments and soft landscaping drawings.
