Details of appointed engineer (condition 4 of permission 2014/4559/P dated 30/03/2015), for the excavation of basement beneath the footprint of the existing building and part of rear garden, and erection of single storey rear extension.

The full impact of the extent of the proposed development has been previously assessed. The requirements of this condition therefore relate purely to the demonstration of the appropriate appointment of a suitably qualified chartered engineer.



The submitted details show that the appointed engineers are chartered, with membership of the appropriate professional bodies and hold the relevant qualifications (CEng/MICE). The appointee's responsibilities have been outlined in submitted reports and are considered to be in accord with the section 106 agreement criteria.

As such, the proposed details are in general accordance with policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policy DP27 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies. The proposed development also accords with the London Plan 2016; the National Planning Policy Framework 2012.

2 Please note that any subsequent change or reappointment of the chartered engineers must be confirmed with the Council forthwith for the duration of the construction works.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
