My neighbour has a 50ft tree on the boundary, and I also have large trees on our boundary. It will be impossible to ensure that the new extension is protected from future damage from the trees, either from falling branches or from tree root ingress to the foundations, as it is too close to the trees. I would not accept liability for this if an extension was approved. It is also highly possible that the extension foundations would impact the integrity of the foundations of the boundary wall between us, and reduce surface water drainage. Achilles Road (and Hillfield Road of which Berridge Mews is a part) have significant issues with subsidence. New foundations being dug so close to the massive retaining wall between Berridge Mews and Achilles Road is highly likely to add to the subsidence risk.

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
