



I am extremely concerned about the above planning application, 156 West End Lane, for the following reasons:

1. The proposed additional residential units will increase the population density in an area that is already crowded and has a large number of new residential units due to open shortly opposite West Hampstead Underground Station.
2. Pavement crowding is even now a safety concern during peak travel periods, when pedestrians spill out from the pavement onto the road when walking between the three stations.
3. The proposed additional residential units will inevitably attract further traffic on roads that are currently extremely congested, causing traffic nuisance and pollution.
4. The high-rise nature of the proposed development will be an unwelcome and oppressive influence on a charming neighbourhood.
