I am extremely concerned about the above planning application, 156 West End Lane, for the following reasons:

- 1. The proposed additional residential units will increase the population density in an area that is already crowded and has a large number of new residential units due to open shortly opposite West Hampstead Underground Station.
- 2. Pavement crowding is even now a safety concern during peak travel periods, when pedestrians spill out from the pavement onto the road when walking between the three stations.
- 3. The proposed additional residential units will inevitably attract further traffic on roads that are currently extremely congested, causing traffic nuisance and pollution.
- 4. The high-rise nature of the proposed development will be an unwelcome and oppressive influence on a charming neighbourhood.
