Please find attached the tree locations plan DAA TL02 and a copy of the tree survey schedule DAA TS 01. There is a table inset into the plan which provides the tree works specification.

The two trees to be removed are a Quince and Mulberry and are of 4.5m and 5.5m in height respectively. Both trees are largely screened in public views by a Silver Wattle tree growing in the adjacent property - this is shown in a photo inset into the plan. The Quince and the Mulberry are small mature trees. The Mulberry had a woolly aphid infection at the time of the survey. Our client is in the process of renovating the property and as a key part of this would like to re-landscape the front garden. As a part of the overall scheme 1 x Prunus subhirtella 'Autumnalis' of 10-12cm girth will be planted in the front garden.
