## Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Himalyan Birch (left side) - reduce and reshape crown by up to 1m all round to suitable new growing points, thin and clean out crown, remove deadwood, weak and suppressed branches and lift canopy by 0.5-1m all round and level off 'browse line'.

- 1 x Kanzan Cherry (left side) Reduce back all overlong laterals by up to 1m all round to suitable new growing points, thin and clean out crown, remove deadwood, weak and suppressed branches and lift and balance crown.
- 1 x Cherry (centre) remove the unbalanced upper crown area back to new growing points, reduce and reshape the left side lateral crown spread by up to 50% Remove lowest main trunk epicormic growth, retain central trunk epicormic growth to create new crown and lift and balance crown

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 21 September 2016 and does not wish to object.

1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is



completed, which ever is the sooner.

- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
- Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
