



Proposed ceiling to be hung from existing joists Soft Connection at Cornice Lower Moulding Proposed Ceiling Level

- Proposed Original Cornice Visible

The Master Bedroom ceiling is to be lowered to provide a degree of acoustic separation that is currently non existing between Flat 4 and Flat 9. The intervention proposed is a reversible solution that does not harm the existing fabric. This will allow the ceiling to provide acoustic attenuation in accordance with modern standards whilst maintaining the integrity of the existing ceiling and causing it no harm.

The ceiling will be lowered 135mm leaving the lower moulding of the original existing cornice visible to the eye. Whilst the coving of the cornice remains intact concealed behind the proposed ceiling, the lower moulding remains visually coherent. This allows the ceiling and cornice to be returned to its original state.
