NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A CONSERVATION AREA

Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Deodar Cedar (T1) - reduce overlong lateral branches by up to 2m back into the main crown line, thin through the crown from branch tip to centre of the tree by 10%

1 x Silver Birch (T2) - reduce the lateral spread over the lawn by 1 - 1.25m, thin through the crown by 5 - 10%

Various x 1 - Hollies, Tree Privet and Holm Oak (T3) - reduce the height by 1 - 1.5m, prune the lateral spread over Brookfield Mansions footpath back by up to 1m

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 03 October 2016 and does not wish to object.


