airport on April 3.
Despite last Wednesday's sentencing, her supporters say no formal charges have been put

on record - although they believe she has been marked out as a

threat to "national security".

In an internet post, husband Richard Ratcliffe said: "There have been no charges. Nazanin has informed her family that she has been required to sign a confession under duress, its content unknown.

"It is hard to understand how a young mother and her small
