# Clarity worker jail shock

A CHARITY worker who was mysteriously detained in Iran on secret charges has been sentenced to five years in prison.

Nazanin Zaghari-Ratcliffe, who lived with her husband in West Hampstead, was separated from her 22-month-old daughter Gabriella after she was suddenly seized at Khomeini airport on April 3.

Despite last Wednesday's sentencing, her supporters say no formal charges have been put

on record – although they believe she has been marked out as a threat to "national security".

In an internet post, husband Richard Ratcliffe said: "There have been no charges. Nazanin has informed her family that she has been required to sign a confession under duress, its content unknown.

"It is hard to understand how a young mother and her small

child on holiday could be considered an issue of national security."

For many months Ms Zaghari-Ratcliffe was

passport confiscated and is under the care of her grandparents in Iran.

Hampstead and Kilburn MP Tulip Siddiq described the case this week as a "travesty of justice" and Amnesty International released a statement saying Ms Zaghari-Ratcliffe "must be charged with a recognisable offence, or released".

At the time of her arrest, she was working as a project manager for the Thomson-Reuters Foundation.

Sergeant Matt Britnell said they are looking to build stronger links with the community after changes to local policing in recent years.

A public meeting will be held at Finchley Road 02 Centre on Saturday from 1pm, with a crime prevention seminar held at 2pm. A second meeting will be held at Coram's Field on October 8 and another on November 26 at Friends House in Euston Road.
