Lack of space for rubbish bins is a pre-existing problem on Gilden Crescent that would be made worse under the plans for 139-141 Queen's Crescent.

The two waste bins on Gilden Crescent are designated for trade use by market traders on Queen's Crescent, however in practice are used by many of the residents on the South side of Gilden Crescent, as there are no household waste bins located on the street. This leads to an almost-daily situation of rubbish overflowing onto the street, and has been subject to significant resident concern in recent years.

The plans for the construction of new flats at 139-141 Queen's Crescent (which in practice are located on Gilden Crescent), do not currently include a bin storage area. The plans being approved in their current way would therefore exasperate the rubbish problem, with four more households bringing their rubbish onto Gilden Crescent.

I am writing to ask the Planning Committee to require a new bin storage area for waste and recycling bins for the residents of these new flats be incorporated into the plans as a planning condition.
