T7-Olive tree- Reduce vertices branches by 0.5 metres.

T8- Olive- Reduce by 1.5 metres.

T8- Cherry- Prune back branches overhanging roof of 22 Tanzania Road by two metres.

T9 Fig Prune back branches overhanging roof to fence line (poles from roof).
