Dear sir/Madam

I am extremely worried about the planning application, 156 West End Lane, for the following reasons:

1. The proposed additional residential units will increase the population density in an area that is already over crowded and has a large number of new residential units due to open shortly opposite West Hampstead Underground Station.
2. The vast scale of this development will inflict a huge negative effect on the natural light for the families and homes on Lymington Rd.
3. The threat to the locally loved and much used Crown Close open space and children's playground.
4. Pavement crowding is even now a real safety concern during peak travel periods, when pedestrians spill out from the pavement onto the road when walking between the three stations.
5. The proposed additional residential units will inevitably attract further traffic on roads that are currently extremely congested, causing traffic nuisance and pollution.
6. An additional high-rise in the nature of the proposed development will be an unwelcome and oppressive influence on a charming neighbourhood.
