Proposed Work:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Amelanchier spp - Prune all round by 0.5-0.75m, crown lift to 3m above ground

1 x Crab Apple - Fell by sectional takedown

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Cherry - Fell by sectional takedown

1 x London Plane - Reduce height and overall spread by 2.5-3m, thin crown by 5%, crown

lift to 4.5m above ground level

1 x Sycamore - Fell by sectional takedown

1 x Ash - Reduce height and lateral spread by 2-2.5m

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 14 September 2016 and does not wish to object.

- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS
