Such noise would include both structure-borne noise (eg. heavy footsteps, jumping, running, ball bouncing) and airborne noise (eg. talking, shouting, music). The proposed terrace would be directly above one of my bedrooms and next to the other bedroom and, given the converted nature of the building, there is no soundproofing at all between any of the flats. Additionally, and importantly, none of the windows in my flat are double-glazed so airborne sound very easily travels through. I have lived in my property for more than 5 years and during this time, the applicant/owner of Flat 3 has demonstrated a consistent lack of any real regard for noise concerns, including playing loud music, children running, jumping and throwing toys such as balls. They also have a tendency to stay up late until the early hours of the morning (often times until 3am) which has been badly disruptive to my sleep. I am therefore extremely concerned that approving a roof terrace would serve to increase the size, space and opportunity for such noise to continue and severely further impact the quality of my life which, due to the consistent disturbance in the main property, so far has already led to negative effects in a number of other areas of my life including work. I am happy to discuss further and can provide examples of the noise issues to support my concerns.
