I object to the above planning application.

Oseney Crescent is part of the Bartholemew Estate Conservation area and deserves to have additional consideration given in circumstances where there is any development that may erode the unique character of the area.

This roof terrace is not in keeping with the established buildings in this area; the proposed extension would alter the rear elevation of the building and its profile, as well as the view across and down the gardens from all adjacent properties, moreover it could set a precedent for others to also attempt to build unsuitable rear extensions along the street. Were this proposed building work to go ahead then the proposed structure would change the current pleasant and green vista for the immediate neighbours considerably.

It would also overlook/overshadow and further compromise the privacy and peaceful existence of the adjoining neighbours and cause unnecessary upset and noise during its construction. If it is built it will increase the noise in the neighbourhood when it is in use, thus preventing the neighbours from the quiet enjoyment of their own homes and gardens.
