DECISION

Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended)

Full Planning Permission Granted Subject to a Section 106 Legal Agreement

Proposal:

Erection of five-storey building including excavation of basement to provide 1 x 4 bed maisonette (Class C3) and retail (Class A1) at ground and basement level. Drawing Nos: 101_PA_100 Rev C, 101_PA_200 Rev C, 101_PA_300 Rev B, 101_PA_310, 101_PA_410, 101_PA_020 Rev A, Basement Impact Assessment prepared by Michael Hadi Associates Ltd dated by 27th of July 2015, 101 PA 020, 101 EX 200,

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant permission subject to the following condition(s):

Condition(s) and Reason(s):

101_PA_010, Design and Access Statement.

1 The development hereby permitted must be begun not later than the end of three years from the date of this permission.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).



2 The development hereby permitted shall be carried out in accordance with the following approved plans: 01_PA_100 Rev B, 01_PA_200 Rev A, 01_PA_300 Rev B, 101_PA_310, 101_PA_410, 101_PA_020 Rev A, Basement Impact Assessment prepared by Michael Hadi Associates Ltd dated by 27th of July 2015, 101_PA_020, 101_EX_200, 101_PA_010, Design and Access Statement.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt and in the interest of proper planning.

3 Sample panels of all facing materials shall be provided on site and approved in writing by the local planning authority before the relevant parts of the works are commenced.

The sample panel of the concrete shall be no smaller than 1m x 1m and shall demonstrate the colour, finish and texture of the material.

The development shall be carried out in accordance with the approval given. The sample panel shall be retained on site until the work has been completed.

Reason: To safeguard the appearance of the premises and the character of the immediate area in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP24 and DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

4 Prior to commencement of development details of a sustainable urban site drainage system (SUDs) shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. Such system shall be based on a 1:100 year event with 30% provision for climate change demonstrating 50% attenuation of all runoff demonstrating greenfield levels of runoff.

The SUDs shall be implemented as part of the development and thereafter retained and maintained.

Reason: To reduce the impact of surface water run-off from the buildings and limit the impact on the storm-water and drainage system from the site in accordance with policies CS13 and CS16 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP22, DP23 and DP32 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

5 Noise levels at a point 1 metre external to sensitive facades shall be at least 5dB(A) less than the existing background measurement (LA90), expressed in dB(A) when all plant/equipment (or any part of it) is in operation unless the plant/equipment hereby permitted will have a noise that has a distinguishable, discrete continuous note (whine, hiss, screech, hum) and/or if there are distinct impulses (bangs, clicks, clatters, thumps), then the noise levels from that piece of plant/equipment at any sensitive façade shall be at least 10dB(A) below the LA90,

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expressed in dB(A).

Reason: To safeguard the amenities of the adjoining premises and the area generally in accordance with the requirements of policy CS5 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP26 and DP28 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

6 Prior to commencement of development details of the proposed cycle storage shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. Please refer to Camden's Planning Guidance document CPG7 (Transport) for details of acceptable cycle parking layouts.

The cycle storage shall be completed in accordance with the approved details prior to first occupation of the development and shall be retained thereafter.

Reason: To ensure the development provides adequate cycle parking facilities in accordance with the requirements of policy CS11of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP17of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

7 Prior to construction the development hereby approved shall submit an energy statement demonstrating how a 19% reduction in carbon dioxide emissions beyond Part L 2013 Building Regulations in line with the energy hierarchy has been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. Prior to occupation, evidence demonstrating that the approved measures have been implemented shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority and shall be retained and maintained thereafter.

Reason: To ensure the development contributes to minimising the effects of, and can adapt to a changing climate in accordance with policies CS13 (Tackling climate change through promoting higher environmental standards) and DP22 (Promoting sustainable design and construction).

8 The residential unit hereby approved shall be designed and constructed in accordance with Building Regulations Part M4 (2).

Reason: To ensure that the internal layout of the building provides flexibility for the accessibility of future occupiers and their changing needs over time, in accordance with the requirements of policy CS6 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP6 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

9 The development hereby approved shall achieve a maximum internal water use of 105litres/person/day, allowing 5 litres/person/day for external water use. Prior to occupation, evidence demonstrating that this has been achieved shall be submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority.

Reason: To ensure the development contributes to minimising the need for further water infrastructure in an area of water stress in accordance with policies CS13 (Tackling climate change through promoting higher environmental standards), DP22 (Promoting sustainable design and construction) and DP23 (Water)

10 Detailed drawings, or samples of materials as appropriate, in respect of the following, shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority before the relevant part of the work is begun:

a) Typical details of new railings and terrace enclosures panels at a scale of 1:10 with any finials at 1:1, including materials, finish and method of fixing.

b) Details of the proposed shopfront, including details and location of any signage, in plan, elevation and section at a scale of no less than 1:20.

c) Plan, elevation and section drawings, including jambs, head and cill, of all new window and door at a scale

d) Details of typical façade junctions details including roof junction; glazing, bronze and concrete elements at a scale of no less than 1:5.

The relevant part of the works shall then be carried in accordance with the approved details

Reason: To safeguard the appearance of the premises and the character of the immediate area in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP24 and DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

11 The development hereby approved shall not commence until such time as a suitably qualified chartered engineer with membership of the appropriate professional body has been appointed to inspect, approve and monitor the critical elements of both permanent and temporary basement construction works throughout their duration to ensure compliance with the design which has been checked and approved by a building control body. Details of the appointment and the appointee's responsibilities shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority prior to the commencement of development. Any subsequent change or reappointment shall be confirmed forthwith for the duration of the construction works.

Reason: To safeguard the appearance and structural stability of neighbouring buildings and the character of the immediate area in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies and policy DP27 (Basements and Lightwells) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies 12 The development shall not be constructed other than in accordance with the conclusions, methodologies and recommendations of the Basement Impact Assessment by Michael Haidi Associates Ltd dated July 2015 hereby approved, including inter alia the need for further pre-commencement trial excavations and pre-condition surveys, monitoring and surface water mitigation measures. In the event that further evidence of site or building conditions necessitate amendments to the BIA or associated methodologies they shall be submitted to the local planning authority for approval in writing prior to the commencement of development and the development shall be constructed in accordance with such amendments.

Reason: To safeguard the appearance and structural stability of neighbouring buildings and the character of the immediate area in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies and policy DP27 (Basements and Lightwells) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies

13 Prior to first occupation of the residential element of the development, the kitchen window shall be obscure glazed and fitted with restrictors which limit the opening to no more than 100mm. Prior to first use of the 1st floor terrace the fixed glazed panel facing Bruges Place shall be obscure glazed. These measures shall be permanently retained as such thereafter.

Reason: In order to prevent unreasonable loss of privacy to neighbouring premises in accordance with the requirements of policy CS5 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP26 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies

- 1 Your proposals may be subject to control under the Building Regulations and/or the London Buildings Acts which cover aspects including fire and emergency escape, access and facilities for people with disabilities and sound insulation between dwellings. - 2 Noise from demolition and construction works is subject to control under the Control of Pollution Act 1974. 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- 3 Your attention is drawn to the fact that there is a separate legal agreement with the Council which relates to the development for which this permission is granted. Information/drawings relating to the discharge of matters covered by the Heads of Terms of the legal agreement should be marked for the attention of the Planning Obligations Officer, Sites Team, Camden Town Hall, Argyle Street, WC1H 8EQ.
- 4 You are reminded that this decision only grants permission for permanent residential accommodation (Class C3). Any alternative use of the residential units for temporary accommodation, i.e. for periods of less than 90 days for tourist or short term lets etc, would constitute a material change of use and would require a further grant of planning permission.
