# 1 Reason for Refusal:

The display of the shroud advertisement, by reason of its size, scale and prominent location, would be an obtrusive addition which would be harmful to the visual amenity of the streetscene, the character and appearance of the conservation area and the setting of the surrounding listed buildings, contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting High Quality Places and Conserving Our Heritage) of the London



Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
