The development hereby permitted must be begun not later than the end of three years from the date of this permission.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).



All new external work shall be carried out in materials that resemble, as closely as possible, in colour and texture those of the existing building, unless otherwise specified in the approved application.

Reason: To safeguard the appearance of the premises and the character of the immediate area in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP24 and DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

The development hereby permitted shall be carried out in accordance with the following approved plans: 01\_DD, 02\_DD, 03\_DD, 04\_DD, 05\_DD, 06\_DD, 07\_DD, 08\_DD, 09\_DD, 10\_DD, 21\_DD, 22\_DD, 23\_DD, 24\_DD, 25\_DD, 26\_DD. 27\_DD, 28\_DD, 29\_DD, Design and Access Statement.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt and in the interest of proper planning.

The boundary wall shall be (i) rebuilt using the retained bricks of the existing wall and the new brickwork shall match the bond and mortar mix of the existing wall; or (ii) in accordance with details submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority.

Reason: To safeguard the appearance of the premises and the character of the immediate area in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP24 and DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
