They give the garden of this Grade 2 listed building the appearance of a shanty town.</p> <p>We think it is important that the planning team set a tight limit on these types of incongruent developments and uphold Camden's own standard to maintain conservation areas.</p> <p>Furthermore these structures have only one purpose; to allow more people to consume more alcohol in the garden. This in itself is in breach of Camden Council's own Special Policy Area status for Camden Town and the principle of limiting the cumulative impact of alcohol consumption in the SPA.</p>
