One change is that we have listed no. 9 South End Road as a "shopfront of merit". It along with just a few others in this parade retain original glazing bars and recessed entrance (this can also be seen at another tea room further north, no. 55). The proposal to replace these original features with sliding windows would be damaging to the conservation area and contrary to CPG1: "Shopfront alterations should respect the detailed design, materials, colour and architectural features of the shopfront and building itself." The guidance also states: "Where there is an existing shopfront recess - often found in older traditional |
| | | | | | shopfronts e.g. listed buildings and conservation areas - they should be retained." |
| | | | | | Some improvements, however, could be made to the shopfront such as replacing the modern tiling on the entrance and stall riser with more traditional finishes and re-locating the badly sited extractor fan in the fanlight. |
