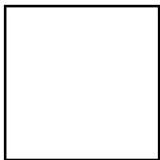
Many thanks for your help this afternoon.

I wish to object to the above Planning application for 6 Regent's Park Terrace, London NW1 7EE. This property backs directly onto ours at 69 Gloucester Crescent, London NW1 7EG.

- 1) The rear elevation indicates plate glass doors quite out of keeping with other doors in both Regent's Park Terrace and Gloucester Crescent. When we installed a door and an outside staircase, we were instructed, quite rightly, that the door should match windows in the property and have glazing bars, which it has
- 2) The proposed new games room and dining room will encroach on the space and light between the houses
- 3) Together with the proposed extension, the external walkway will encroach seriously on the privacy of our garden
- 4) The owners of the property did not see fit to consult their rear neighbours over the plans
