Proposal: Details pursuant to Condition 4 (details of windows) of planning permission 2016/1020/P (dated 08/08/2016) for creation of a studio flat (Class C3) at ground floor level within existing residential building.

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant permission.

Informatives:

1 Permission was granted on 8/8/2016 for creation of a studio flat (Class C3) at ground floor level within existing residential building (ref: 2016/1020/P). Condition 4 of this application required details of windows to be provided.

However, prior to this, permission was granted on 9/1/2015 for replacement of existing windows and ground-floor entrance doors (ref: 2014/6811/P).

The windows approved in the 2014 application are not proposed to be changed



and therefore this condition can be discharged.

The sites planning history has been taken into account when coming to this decision.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP24 and DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
