Repairs have already taken place to the side wall of 29 Kylemore Road due to movement and the proposed structure would likely create further instability and remove any access to the side wall in the future should further works be required.  In addition the area of West Hampstead is known for subsidence issues and digging at the depth required to create the foundations close to the water level will make the risk even greater and therefore of massive concern.  The proposed gate is in a high brick wall which already has significant cracking and suggests that there may already be structural issues that exist, there is no suggested proposal to rectify this issue.	
					Finally – I have no objection to some form of building in the garden of 36 Hemstal, either adjoining the building or along the side wall as long as the distance between 29 Kylemore and the proposed structure ensures no impact to the structure and foundations of 29 Kylemore road and access to the aforementioned side wall.
