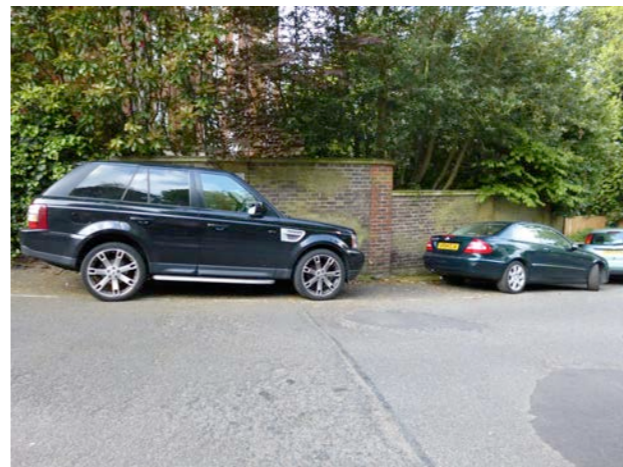


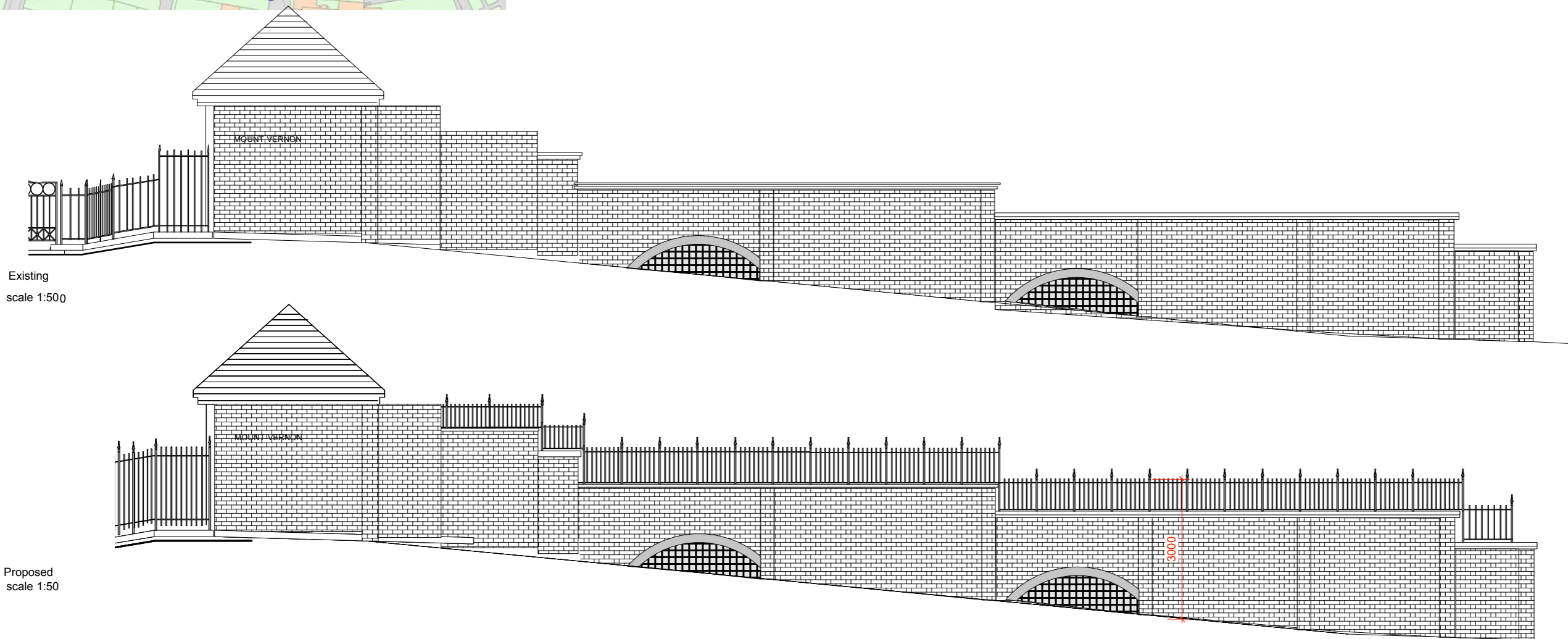
A WALLS ON FROGGNAL RISE (NORTH OF ENTRANCE)



The combination of steep gradient, low walls and car parking makes the walls easy to climb. The addition of the steel railings would compensate for this and once planting has grown up around the railings, the addition would not be very visible.



The adjacent area has a variety of fencing. A common combination is steel railing and brick as can be seen from the above photograph.
