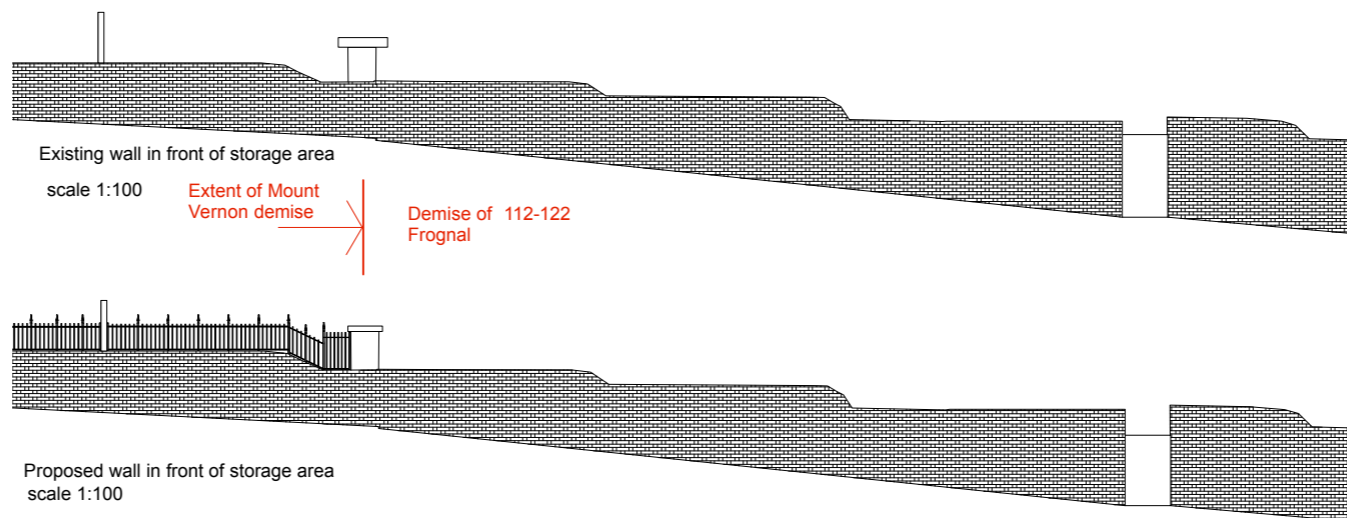
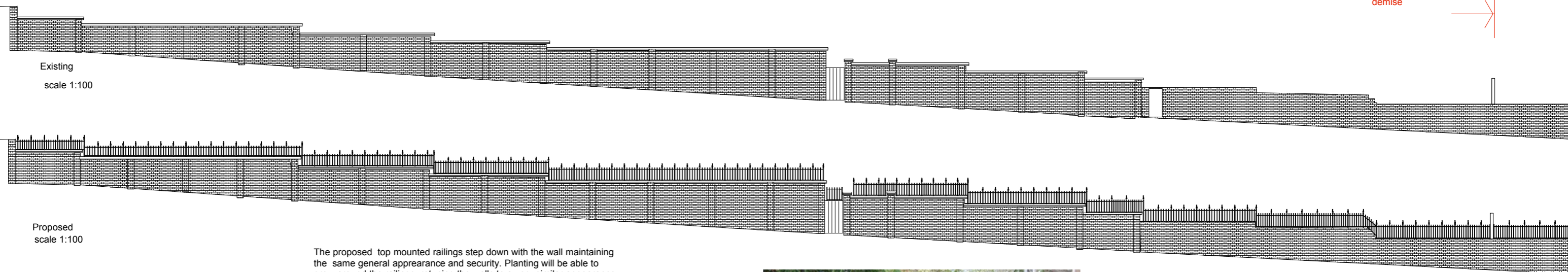


C. WALLS ON FROGNAL

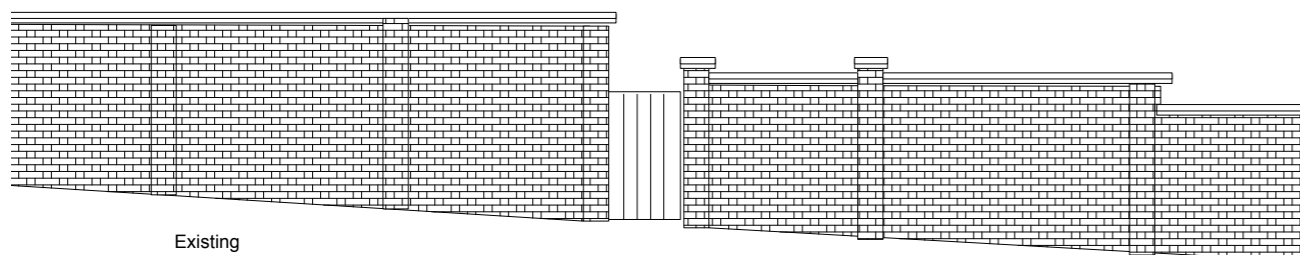


View down Froggnal showing Mount Vernon apartments on the left

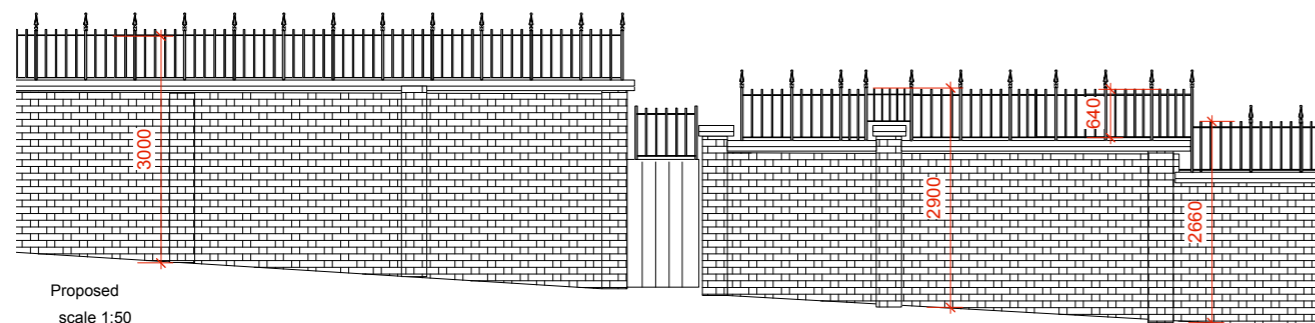

A. TYPICAL WALL ON FROGNAL



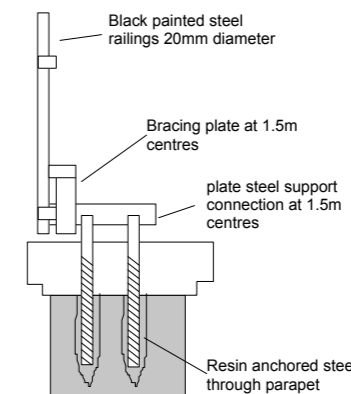
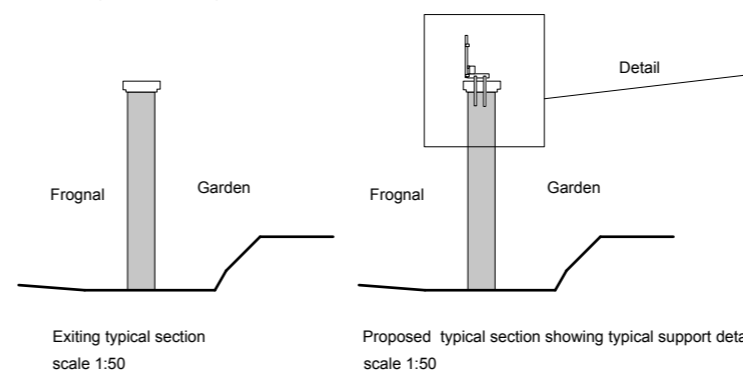
Existing scale 1:50
