Protection of retail space is extremely important; without protection, no doubt a very sizeable proportion of shops would be turned into flats. The arguments presented by Messrs Christo indicate that too high a rent is being asked - hence no takers. This is no argument for change of use. The space has been used as a gallery and is highly suitable for that purpose - or possibly as workshops or studios.
