					o The proposed development is over-scaled and too large for the site. It fails to respect the scale, mass and character of the area, which is predominately characterised by traditional, low rise housing.
					o The development, due to its excessive height and bulk, will have a harmful impact on the character and quality of the Conservation Area. The scale of the development is inappropriately large for this back-land site and fails to respect the grain of existing development.
					o The scale of the development also means it will have a harmful impact on adjacent homes, and in particular will have an adverse impact on the Grade II listed terrace at $22 - 32$ Winscombe Street.
					o The closeness of the development to surrounding gardens and homes will cause a loss of privacy as a result of the proposed windows, balconies and terraces directly overlooking both homes and rear gardens, as well as causing harmful noise intrusion and overlooking.
					o The buildings are built up to the boundary on three sides and within 1m of the public path on the west side. If the scheme were approved it would set a dangerous precedent for developers to exploit on other sites in Camden.
					o No affordable housing is provided, in violation of Camden's own policies.
