The applicant should be required to provide these before any decision is made. The supporting document labelled "layout plan" does not provided the needed detail of the exact measurements of the pavement. As a result, the CGCA cannot determine whether adequate space is left on the pavement for pedestrians. The same applies to the A-board. The document, "signage details," gives measurements of the street furniture, but not the measurements of the space available for pedestrians. As the Council is well aware, pubs, restaurants, cafes and shops often place street furniture, particularly A-boards, in the pavement in such a way that it obstructs pedestrian flow. Thus, it is essential that an accurate layout, with accurate measurements, is included so the Council, the applicant and local residents have a precise record of what has been permitted.
