The applicant should be required to provide these before any decision is made.</p> <p>The supporting document labelled "layout plan" does not provided the needed detail of the exact measurements of the pavement. As a result, the CGCA cannot determine whether adequate space is left on the pavement for pedestrians. The same applies to the A-board.</p> <p>The document, "signage details," gives measurements of the street furniture, but not the measurements of the space available for pedestrians.</p> <p>As the Council is well aware, pubs, restaurants, cafes and shops often place street furniture, particularly A-boards, in the pavement in such a way that it obstructs pedestrian flow. Thus, it is essential that an accurate layout, with accurate measurements, is included so the Council, the applicant and local residents have a precise record of what has been permitted.</p>
