Here are the following information from your request

CCTV camera monitoring will have the following:-

- 1) CCTV signage installed on site
- 2) duty manager will have responsibility of the CCTV and will make regular checks to ensure procedures are followed
- 3)client will be registering with the information commissioner's office

LED Security Light :-

Equipment will have 40% uniformity and work with the CCTV to gain images of people's faces on a minimum 2.4m mounting height

It will be low energy lamps in vandal resistant luminaires positioned out of easy reach and switched by a photo electric cell (dusk to dawn lighting)

Lighting should have a minimum illuminance lux level of 8

Security Gate :-

In regards to security doors, the client does not want to install LPS 1175 sr2 as the security door as it doesn't match the wall we have.

And we need to have a sliding door due to the fact that the door cant open out into public space and we cant open inwards due to it hitting the ramp access behind

the wooden border wall has the proposed sliding door entrance to the open landscaped area , its not a door entering into the actual building.

And the security gate is part of a wooden wall for the landscaped area. The height of the wooden security gate is 2 metres which is on a metal guide rail.

The security door is a solid wood sliding door so would not be prone to anyone trying to use bodily force and the actual lock will be a standard gate padlock from the inside

Also if an opportunist was to somehow gain entry past this gate door, they are only in the open landscape yard and not inside the building which will have a proper security door

And will be captured on CCTV over the landscaped area.
