T1. Willow- Repollard the crown at the original pollard points, as indicated by the straight lines drawn in photo 2 (see Arboriculture Report attached). This will reduce the tree to a point approximately 1 to 2m beyond the current pollard points. The crown to be reshaped to leave a natural rounded shape.

T2. Birch- Reduce the height by up to 1.5m beyond the previous pruning points. The rest of the crown to be reduced back towards previous pruning positions to leave a natural outline.
