

22 Southampton Place, Holborn

Note: 4th floor mansard office/flat a modern addition and believed the whole of the interior was gutted and renewed at that time. All joists appear new. The lift shaft is formed in reinforced concrete. The adjacent WCs core is formed of modern brick and the stair appears to be of modern form. Ceilings all plasterboard in one or two layers fitted below 50mm softwood counterbattens running at 90 degrees to joists.
