It has come to my attention that a planning application has been submitted for the above property for installation of two windows to the rear of ground floor flat.

Unfortunately we have no option but to **object** to the installation of windows. This site is adjacent to London Underground operational railway and poses a potential risk to the safety of our structures, passengers and staff.

The reasons for our objection are:

- These windows open directly over the railway – London Underground would normally object to such proposals for the safety of the railway
- These windows cannot be installed or maintained without entering London Underground land – again, unacceptable risk to the safety of the railway
- Windows on this elevation are subject to a relevant Legal Agreement and may require varying of, at least, the 1944 Agreement in respect to windows and openings overlooking the railway at 1 to 11 Canfield Place

This property is a Network Rail asset and they should be consulted directly.
