Proposed Work:

WITHIN GROUNDS: 1 x Cedar - Cut back from roof area. 1 x Leylandii - Cut back from patio area and reduce in height to approximately 4m. 5 x Sycamores - Pollard to previous points. 1 x Horse Chestnut - Lift crown to approximately 4m and cut back from building to give minimum clearance of approximately 3m. 2 x Holly - Reduce to approximately 3m and clip front face. 5 x Sycamores - Remove ivy and lift crown to 6m. 1 x Holly - Reduce all round by approximately 1m. 1 x Yew - Trim to reshape. 1 x Yew - Crown lift to approximately 4m. 1 x Leylandii - Trim overhanging branches. 1 x Purple Leaved Norway Maple - Crown lift over roadside to approximately 3m and crown reduce by approximately 2m. 1 x Purple Leaved Norway Maple - Crown reduce by 2m. 1 x Norway Maple - Cut back from building to give a mimum clearance of approximately 1m and crown reduce remainder by approximately 2m. 1 x Magnolia - Crown lift to approximately 3m and cut back from building.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 11 November 2016 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.
- You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
- Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
