However, I object because as a Northwards facing flat leaseholder with my rear windows, bedroom and reception room overlooking the Generator, my visual amenity will be detrimentally affected.</p> <p>I am also concerned about the health hazard. If there was no risk of health hazard, I believe such antenna would be placed near schools and school children - which they are not. There are children at Knollys House - a block of 41 flats.</p> <p>It is also relevant, I submit, that the Freeholder/Owner of Knollys House has refused to give his landlords' consent to such antenna - as, indeed, have many of the blocks nearby. This is, I believe from both heritage and health reasons.
